Artist Claudia Myatt keeps wonderful watercolour sketchbook diaries of her travels, sailing adventures and everyday life in-between.

'A Sketchbook is where you grow ideas. It is your brain's playground, a visual diary, the colourful, imperfect trace of your life. It's a place where no-one (especially you) can judge what goes on. It's a liberating habit to get into'

This workshop will offer the impetus to start your watercolour sketchbook diary, working fast and loose in pen and wash, experimenting with creative ways to record a colourful visual keepsake of your year.

To help you prepare we have provided a short list of suggested art materials to bring with you below.

These workshops take place in Art Safari's riverside studio, where there is a wealth of material to be seen from the balcony and around the quayside. A light lunch and refreshments are provided.

Keeping a sketchbook diary – what to bring

We will provide basic drawing kit – paper, pencils, pens, paints, drawing boards. Bring whatever sketchbooks you have and whatever drawing media you like to use, but if you're shopping for materials, Claudia recommends:

- A hardback sketchbook in a size that feels comfortable – anything around A4 is usually best. Most sketchbooks contain smooth drawing paper which also takes watercolour and other media; the more you pay, the better the paper. Avoid spiral bound sketchbooks if you can (but if you already have one, that's fine).
- Pencils – 2B are most useful, though you can buy a full set of sketching pencils from 9B to HB if you prefer.
- Pens – I will have sketching pens for you to try out, but again sets are easily available and not expensive.
- For colour work, a small watercolour set is useful (Cotman is a good quality beginner set). Watercolour pencils vary in quality, but all are useful. Derwent Inktense provide the best colour, but I will have various types for you to try if you're not sure what you want to get.
- Brushes – a couple of synthetic watercolour brushes in a size 3 and size 8 will do fine (round brushes should come to a fine point; you don't need flat brushes, fan brushes or riggers)

Art Safari Studio The Harbourmasters Office



The Harbourmasters Office is on Ferry Quay in Woodbridge on the Deben Estuary. We are the middle building with a balcony on the quayside. Our blue front door is upstairs, knock loudly if the door is closed! The Art Safari Studio also has a ground level backdoor entrance. *(Please note that the studio is downstairs, and the toilets are located upstairs.)*

By train/walking:

We're conveniently located a short walk (a few steps!) from Woodbridge Railway Station. Cross the railway line and with the River in front of you look to your left for Ferry Quay.

By car:

Please enter **Art Safari** into your Sat Nav to view the driving directions *(note if you enter the post code the directions will take you to the Tide Mill).*

From the south, leave the A12 onto the B1438, signposted Woodbridge and follow the road into the town. You can park in the station car park on the right (free after 6:00pm)

From the north, leave the A12 onto the A1152, Woods Lane, signposted Orford. At the traffic lights turn right onto Melton Hill and continue into Woodbridge. Turn left at traffic lights onto Quayside and follow the road to the station car park, on the left.

Parking:

There is no parking available at the Art Safari Studio/Harbourmasters Office.

There is a pay and display car park at the Woodbridge Railway Station/Riverside Film Theatre. It is a very short walk away!


